Waivers for more than 5**

**Waivers - Over 5:** This type of waiver is to be issued when the total number of children in the home, including the foster parents' children, will exceed 5.

- 1. Can the home physically accommodate the additional child/children? The accommodations should include a bed, adequate closet space, and room for personal possessions and adequate privacy. Is adequate transportation available for the increased number of children?

- 2. Can the substitute parents meet the needs of another child or children? Would appropriate adult supervision be available at all times when the children are in the home? Is help, relief, or other support available to the family? Is the family managing well with the children already in the home?

The waiver form should be submitted to the Placement Director within 48 hours of placement for signature and, then, the document is forwarded to the CEO for signature.
