1.1 Introduction

The Office of State Court Administrators (OSCA) initiated a request to the Department of Children and Families (DCF) to extract data from the Florida Safe Families Network (FSFN) and provide a file of the data extracted. OSCA would in turn process the file and upload its contents into the Florida Dependency Court Information System (FDCIS). OSCA provided the data elements that requested to be extracted from FSFN along with instructions on how the file should be constructed and frequency of delivery. The architecture of the file was decided during meetings with OSCA. This extract will serve as a point in time look at the specific elements requested by OSCA. OSCA will also construct its own mechanisms to track the history of certain fields if the history of field is required to be maintained in FDCIS. This delivery of information is singular in direction and will flow from FSFN to OSCA.

1.2 Processes Overview

FSFN uses the following selection criteria to gather the data used to compose the OSCA Extract file:

Selection Criteria: Select all active participants in open active cases in which the participant has at least one legal record.

The file will be generated nightly and delivered via Secure File Transfer Protocol (SFTP) to OSCA. The naming convention for the generated files will be OSCA_EXTRACT_YYYYMMDDHHMMSS where the date timestamp is the time the program runs.

FSFN does not monitor the values of fields in FSFN in order to identify updated information instead FSFN will attempt to fill each field of the extract every night. If a data element is not present in FSFN when the file is generated, the field in the file will be blank. FSFN uses the rules documented within Section 1.3 File Composition to compose the file.

The file is participant centered and then broken out by case. Each row of the extract represents a participant that met the selection criteria within the identified case. All the other data elements of that row will pertain to that individual and that case. Similarly if a child meets the selection criteria in multiple cases then multiple rows will be generated in the extract file for that child.

FSFN uses the SFTP protocol to determine if the file was successfully delivered. If the extract batch executes the file delivery routine without receiving an error this is considered a successful transmission. If the file transmission process encounters an error, FSFN will work to resolve the issue. FSFN will deliver files to OSCA as part of this extract. OSCA will not return any information to FSFN.



1.3 Extract File Composition

The FSFN extract file provided to OSCA will contain the following data elements as part of this data sharing project.

The list below contains five columns:

Name: Name of FSFN Element requested by OSCA.

OSCA Definition: The OSCA definition of the requested element.

Page>Tab>Field: This column identifies the page, tab (if necessary) and field of the OSCA requested element.

Comments: This column identifies the logic that will be used when extracting the information from FSFN.

1.4 Requirements

1. **Timeline of services to be provided:** Services are to be provided by June 30, 2011
2. **Services to be provided:** CGI will create a software service to provide a daily export of FSFN data to OSCA
 - During the design phase, CGI will provide OSCA with a description of the software service including a description of incoming files with file naming conventions to be used.
 - CGI will provide OSCA with descriptions of the data fields contained within the files including data field names, data field data types, and field lengths during the design phase.
 - CGI will provide OSCA with the data domain values for the requested FSFN reference tables during the design phase (exhibit B).
 - CGI will provide test files to OSCA prior to implementation.
 - CGI will develop, test and install a daily data export software service from the Florida Safe Families Network (FSFN) system.
 1. The data will be exported from the FSFN system.
 2. The data will be comprised of only FSFN cases that are also dependency court cases.
 3. The data will be provided daily and will be no less than 24hrs old.
 4. This software service will run and supply files to OSCA at anytime during the day that is the least disruptive to the Department of Children and Families' systems.
 5. The software service will be scheduled to run at the same time every day.
 6. The data in the files will match OSCA's requested list of data elements (exhibit A).
 7. The data will be provided in one or more pipe (|) delimited ASCII text files.
 8. The files will contain only new or updated data.
 9. The data will be provided using File Transport Protocol Secure (FTPS).
 - CGI will document the verification of data in the files by picking a random sampling of data and verify the accuracy of the data in the files to the originating system (FSFN). This documentation will be made available to OSCA upon completion of this project.

Requirement Exhibit B has been obsoleted during the design process the construction of the file eliminates the need to provide the FSFN reference values listed in Exhibit B.
